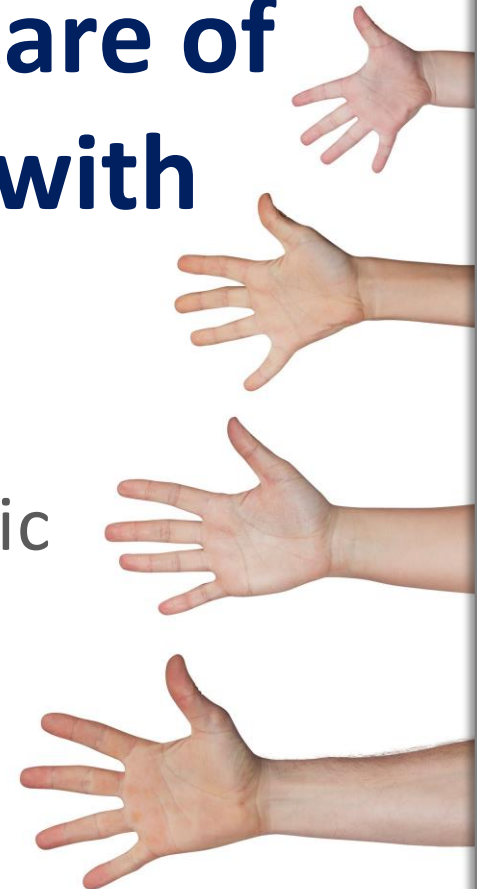

## CONGRESS OBJECTIVES

After 7 years Project involving all 18 ADHD Centres of Lombardy Region (North Italy), the Congress will discuss a few of aspects concerning ADHD care that characterized also the Project. The main object of the Project supported by the Regional Health Ministry was to harmonize diagnosis and treatment for children and adolescents with ADHD, also through a shared organization of Mental Health Services for Children and Adolescents with ADHD.

A pathway of care has been defined to ensure to all children and adolescents with ADHD in Lombardy Region appropriate interventions.

The Project is almost unique not only in Italy, although the results are relevant for the Lombardy Region and as stimulus for the other Italian Regions. However, it seems advisable to expand the confrontation.
